


About the research project



The CLIMB Project is a Cambridge-based team working both locally and with colleagues around the country to improve mental (and physical) health care and research using health data. We are funded by the UK Medical Research Council.

Four key projects are being undertaken to enable better understanding, access and sharing of data for clinical and research use. These are:



Developing research databases to analyse health data securely



Creating better tools to record clinical assessments and questionnaires



Using computer-based predictions to help understand mental health conditions



Involving service users and the public in the work we do

About the research project

The CLIMB Project's national survey will gather patient and public opinion on sharing NHS (England, Scotland, Wales) and HSC (Northern Ireland) health data across the UK, for both health-care and research purposes.

The survey is seeking your views on:

- your current understanding of health data sharing
- how you would like to see identifiable and de-identified health data shared (or not)
- who you would be willing to share your data with
- whether you would be willing to share all types of your health data equally (for clinical or research purposes)
- ideas on what a health data consent form might look like
- your views on data linkage for research, and on a national web portal to sign up for research

The survey is anonymous: the research team will not be able to identify you from your answers. If you want to, you can give an e-mail address to receive updates on the work, but you don't have to. We will publish the results and share them with the NHS/HSC.

Why complete the survey?

Your answers may help the NHS/HSC decide how health data is used in the UK.

Who is eligible to participate in the survey?

You are eligible to participate if you meet the following two criteria:

You are resident in any part of the UK


You are over 16 years old (or under 16 with the consent of a parent / guardian)
