## How to participate in the survey

The CLIMB Project's national survey will gather patient and public opinon on sharing NHS (England, Scotland, Wales) and HSC (Northern Ireland) health data across the UK, for both healthcare and research purposes.

The survey is seeking your views on:

- your current understanding of health data sharing
- how you would like to see identifiable and deidentified health data shared (or not)
- who you would be willing to share your data with
- whether you would be willing to share all types of your health data equally (for clinical or research purposes)
- ideas on what a health data consent form might look like
- your views on data linkage for research, and on a national web portal to sign up for research
