What is Involve Hull?

Involve Hull is a network of patients, carers and members of the public who work with our research teams to help shape our research.

The network enables the voices of people with many different perspectives and experiences to be heard and involved in making decisions about our research.

Joining the network is your chance to influence what we do and how we do it. Get in touch to find out more.

What will I be doing?

By getting involved, you can have your say about:

- The topics we research
- How we carry out our research
- How we recruit patients to take part
- The information we give participants
- How we promote our research

Our pioneering research covers many areas including cancer, primary care, end of life care, healthy pregnancies and alcohol addiction. You can choose which projects you work with.

Who can join?

We are looking for people who:

- Live with a long term health condition
- Look after a loved one who needs care
- Use local health and care services





What are the benefits of joining?

You will be joining a friendly and supportive network. You will get the chance to meet new people, learn new skills and share your existing skills with others.

We will cover your travel and other expenses. We also offer you a fee for the work that you do. This includes research activities that you complete for us from home.

We offer refreshments at all our meetings. We can book a free parking space for you when you visit the university.

We hold social events for members. We will invite you to talks, lectures and cultural events at the university. You can also join the university library.

How much time will I need?

As a volunteer, the amount of time that you contribute is up to you.

If you decide to join our network, we will invite you to a welcome event. We will hold at least four network meetings a year.

We will offer you the chance to get involved in a range of other activities and projects. Some of these can be carried out from home, others will involve visiting the university or other local venue.

Some projects will only need a little bit of help. Other studies and roles might involve a bigger time commitment.
