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## Title of Project

**Behavioural changes in organ donor registration within English Black African and/or Caribbean communities post government announcement and pre implementation of the Deemed Consent Act (2019).**

## Purpose of the research

This study has been conducted as part of a Doctor of Clinical Research qualification at the University of Exeter.

The aim of the study is to explore and uncover themes (motivators and barriers) within Black African and/or Caribbean communities that led to behavioural change i.e. opt-ing in or out of the Organ Donor Register (ODR) after the 2017 English government announcement of the Deemed Consent Act.

This study is looking to recruit 15-20 individuals that identify as a Black African and/or Caribbean. Individuals must be 18 and above, male or female and an English nationality as the study is focused on English legislative changes in organ donation and registration.

## What would taking part involve?

- Complete a 5-10 minute online screening questionnaire to determine eligibility
- 1-2-1 Video conferencing, telephone or face to face (COVID safe) interview with researcher (approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour).
- Participants will be given a £25 Amazon voucher as 'Thank you' (must be eligible and complete interview).
