A new genetic test has now been implemented across fourteen NHS hospitals to predict which babies are at risk of hearing loss due to side effects of antibiotics. The test will use genetic information to enable doctors to prescribe the right type of antibiotic to the right baby at the right time.

PALOH-UK is a research study that is working to evaluate how well this genetic test works and how well it is implemented into routine care. This research study will help decide how the genetic test is used across the UK.
